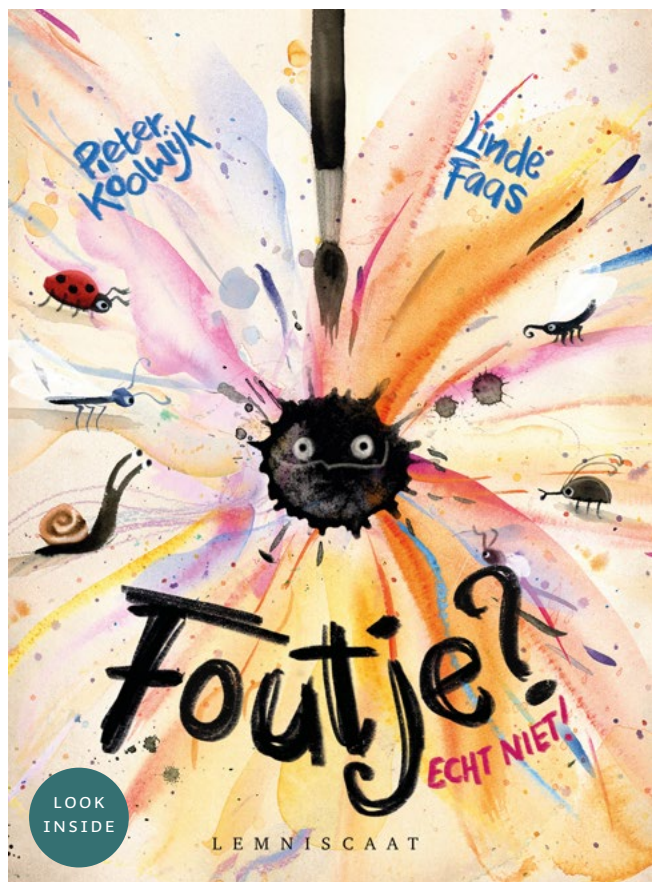

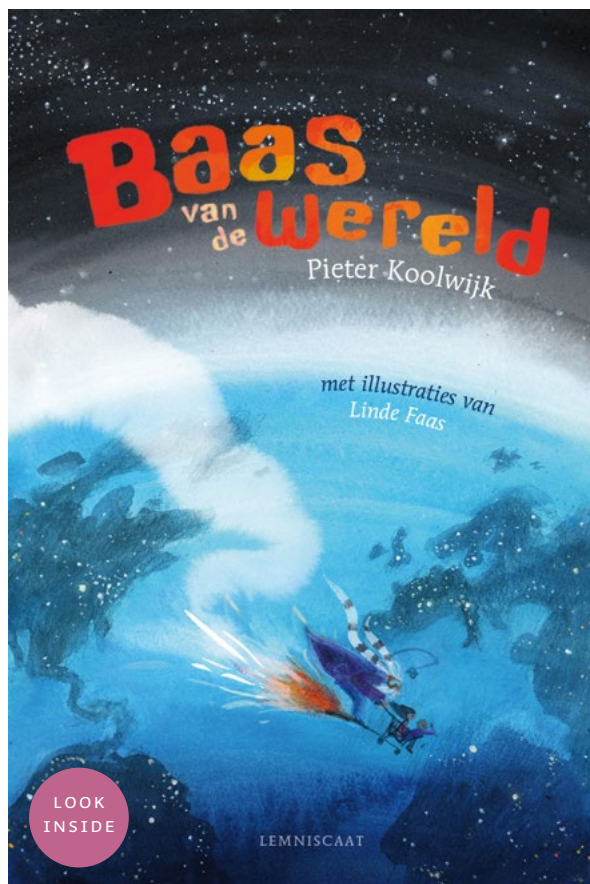

Will the world be all right? And what's in that suspicious brown package that Boss is constantly lugging around?

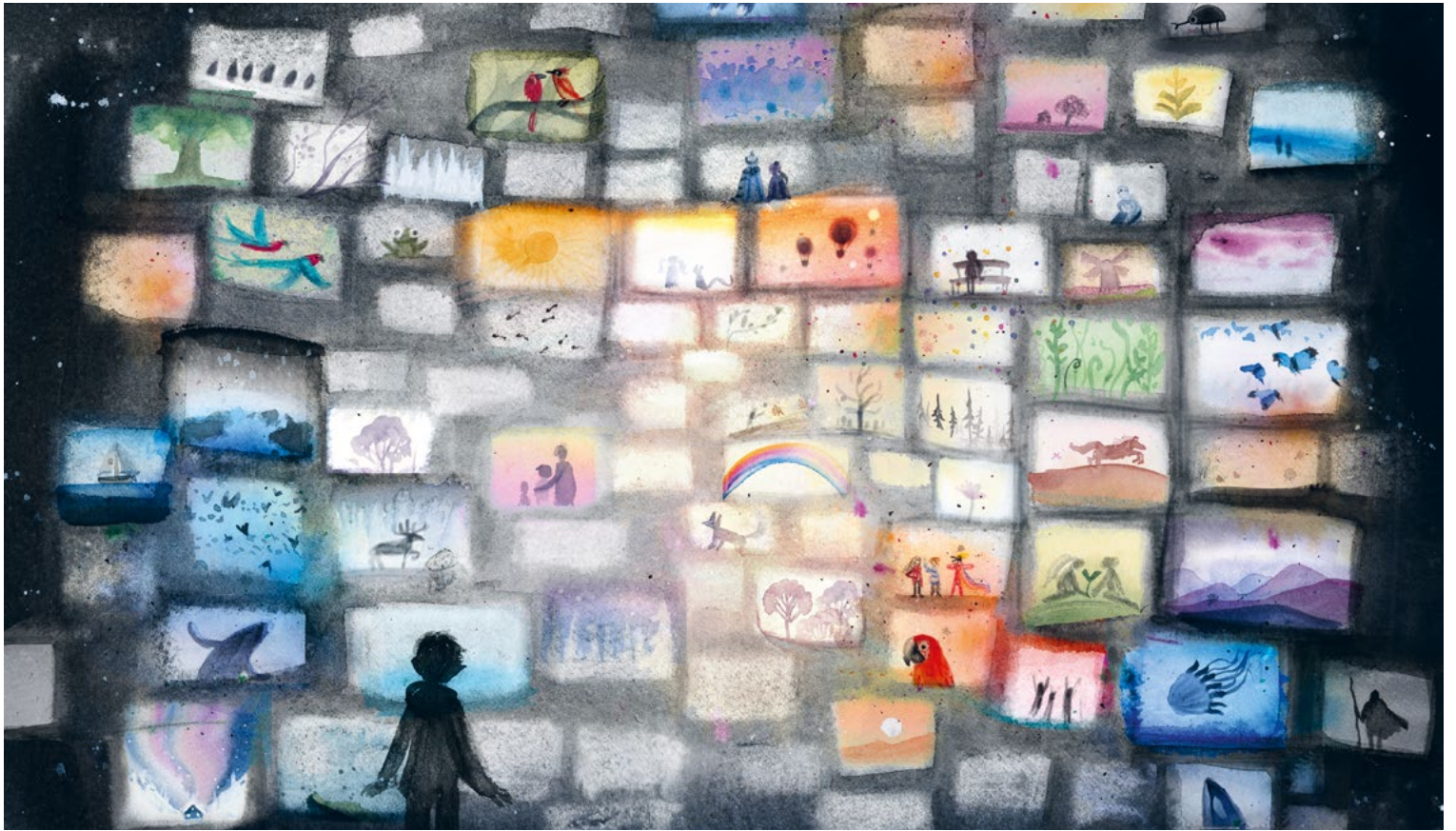

Pim's older brother.

When Pim angrily goes out for an ice cream, she meets Thilo, who has recently moved into their block of apartment buildings. He shows her a secret - a secret, Pim knows, that has everything to do with Hugo. But Thilo doesn't know that yet.

In the week that follows, Pim has to make important choices. How much will she share, and with whom? And most importantly, how should she move on from here? Because once a year has passed, it'll be real. Hugo will not come back. And what to do with Hugo's dead Jackdaw in the freezer?

Kris Terwindt has written a book that will warm your heart. Head-strong Pim and irresistibly cheerful Thilo are an asset to children's literature.

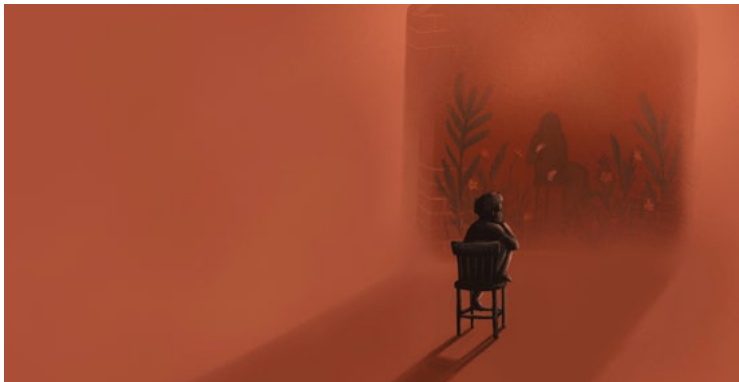


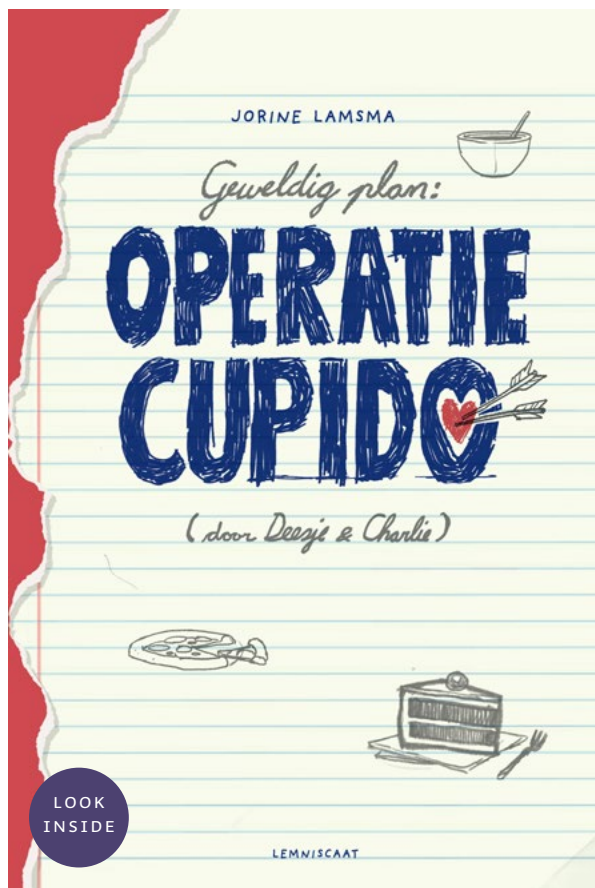

Eighth-graders Deena and Charlie are writing a book together when Deena's life is suddenly turned upside down. Her parents are getting divorced. No one saw it coming, but Deena's mother has fallen in love with another man. Charlie's parents have been separated for ages, so Deena knows that divorce is not the end of the world. Except Charlie has got a jerk of a stepfather. But... of course, that can be solved if Charlie's mother and Deena's father fall in love with each other! Together with the help of Deena's two neighbors, they devise Operation Cupid.

Alternately, the sensitive, insecure Deena and the funny, curious Charlie write down in their own voices how Operations Cupid develops. And meanwhile, 'Ordinary Life' goes on too. With preparation for the final school musical and everything that comes with the last year at primary school. Will Operation Cupid succeed?

Jorine Lamsma drags you into the world of Deena and Charlie from the very first page. Their own voices will leave you laughing, shuddering, frightened, hoping... and longing for more!
